IDENTIFICATION & ALERT

The WasteWatch Cam actively monitors a defined area; when an incident of flytipping occurs, the Al algorithm detects the items left and reads the licence plate of the associated vehicle using ANPR. Alerts are then sent to the responsible parties.

FINE ISSUED

The vehicle's registration can be cross-referenced against the DVLA database, triggering a fine is issued to the offender's address. This has a proven track record of generating revenue for councils while also reducing incidents dramatically.

Data gathered via WasteWatch Cam can be used to trends, track criminal organisations, and pinpoint repeat offenders, a significant contributor to the instances of fly-tipping.
